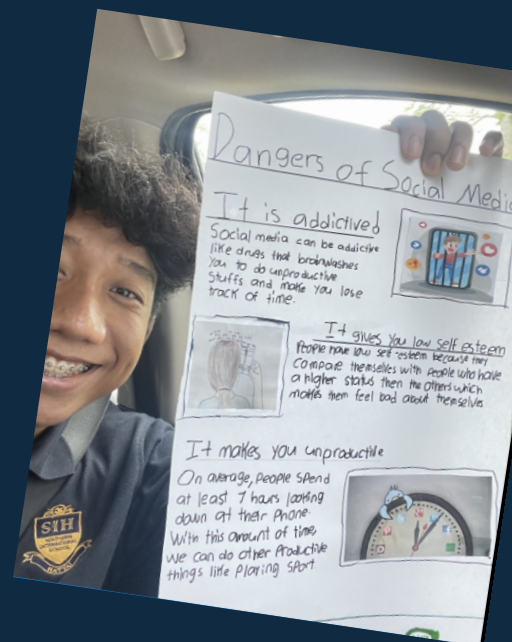

It was extremely hard to choose the winners but Mr Michael decided on the following:

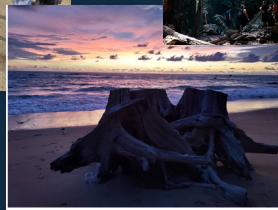
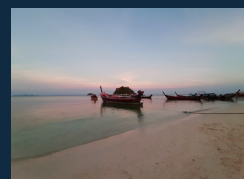
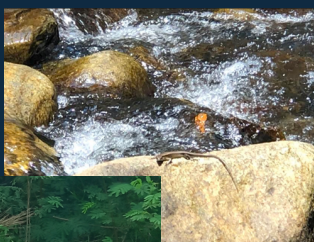
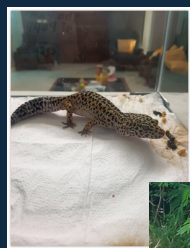
